

Wymore Country Club Twilight League Rules

I. AGREEMENT OF TEAMS

1. Each team is to have a maximum of 6 regular members. Two members must be present to qualify for match play or forfeit the match. (1981)
2. Each team shall have 1 captain. The other 5 and any Substitutes shall be picked by the Captain. (1974)
3. All others who do not wish to play regularly, will be placed on a general substitute list, to be used before using a player from an existing team. (1972)

II. SCORING OF WEEKLY MATCH AND MEDAL PLAY

1. The members of each team, or their substitutes shall be paired for match play. There will be a total of 4 Match points, 2 points per card. (1972)
2. One point is awarded to the team with the lowest low net score for a total of 3 points per card.
3. 3 points are awarded by the combination of the 3 lowest low net scores of the 4 members of the team, for a total of 9 points. (1972)

III. SCHEDULING OF LEAGUE

1. The League Committee will arrange a schedule.
2. All teams must finish play on a scheduled night, or all league play will be forfeited for that night (Inclement Weather). (1972)

IV. RAIN DELAYS

1. When League play is stopped because of rain, it will be considered a RAIN DELAY. It will then be decided by the majority of the members playing, whether it is to wet or dangerous (because of lightning) to continue playing. If it is decided not to play, then all matches will be forfeited for the night. If you have a team member or members leave before league is cancelled, and the league continues after a RAIN DELAY, then your team members who left, will forfeit any points they might have won if they had stayed.

V. DUTIES OF THE CAPTAIN

1. Select other Team members and substitutes.
2. Assist the League Committee in carrying out the functions of the league with his own team members. (1972)
3. Communicating changes in schedule or cancellations to his team. (2021)

VI. FEES AND THE PAYMENT OF FEES

1. The cost for each team will be determined by the League Committee. This cost will be prepaid at the beginning of the season.
2. The captains will collect from their sponsor the necessary fees and turn them in to the League Committee. (1974)

3. Teams will not be allowed to participate until such fees are paid. (2021)

VII. TROPHIES AND AWARDS

1. Your team name will be added to the Winners Plaque. (2000)
2. Weekly prizes will be awarded to the winners of the flag prizes. (1972)
3. League will consist of a first half and a second half. (1982)
4. The winners of both halves will play for First and Second; the second place finishers will play Third and Fourth; the third place finishers will play for Fifth and Sixth and so on.
5. The play-offs will be held the week following the Final League Night (wether permitting). If rained out, it will be up to the captains and League Committee to reschedule. (1982)
6. Substitutes will not be used in the league play-offs. Team members only. (1982)
7. The surplus money in the Golf League Fund will be used for and Hamburger Dinner following the end of the First half of league and a Steak Dinner following the League play-offs. (2021)
8. In years when there is an even number of teams, and a team wins both halves of the league they are playing in, they will have to decide if they want to play as the first half winners or the second half winners. In the years that we have an odd number of teams, a team can win both halves and not have to play in the League play-offs. They will be the automatic winners.

VIII. OTHER RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Winter rules will be followed for the entire League season. (2021)
2. Strokes should be verified at the end of each hole.
3. Handi-caps will be determined on the basis of all scores posted and will be computed weekly.
4. Forfeits will be declared at 6:00 PM against your opponent, if he has not arrived and is not ready for play. This rule can be amended if you have started league play and he joins your group on your first hole, even though he is late. This is totally up to the player who started on time.
5. If a player waiting for his opponent starts before 6:00 PM and his opponent arrives before 6:00 PM, the player who started early will forfeit the match.
6. When there is a question about whether your ball is out of bounds, it will be up to your opponent to decide whether it is in or out. If he declines, it will be up to you to decide.
7. All trees on the course are to be played as hazards. The ball must be playe as is or dropped straight back with the tree still in your line of flight.
8. Any area where a tree has been removed, still containing wood chips or a stump shall be treated as ground under repair. Drop ball not going closer to hole without penalty. (2021)
9. Any ball deemed unplayable can be dropped up to 2 club lengths not going closer to the hole with 1 penalty stroke.
10. If ball lands in low area that is muddy or standing water (i.e., ditch on 1 & 3), ball can be dropped in dry area not going closer to hole without penalty.

11. Tee shots on Holes 1,6 and 9 that land in pond, can be re-teed on the tee box with a 2 stroke penalty or laid out at the point of entry with a 1 stroke penalty. Exception: Hole 6 will have a designated drop location at southeast corner of pond. (1998)
12. If ball is hit into the rough or the triangle that comes into play on holes 1,3 & 4, in order to save time, you have 5 minutes to locate ball. If ball can't be found, another ball can be played from the approximate point of entry with a 1 stroke penalty.
13. If ball is lost anywhere on the course during league play, you have 5 minutes to find the ball. If not found, you and your opponent can decide where to drop the ball in the approximately the same area ball was lost with a 1 stroke penalty. If you cannot agree on drop location, you must go back to where original shot was made with a 1 stroke penalty. (2011)
14. Any league member over 70 years of age, will be able to tee off from the White tees on holes 3 & 8 on both Tuesdays and Thursdays. (2011)
15. Greens Fees golfers can be used as substitutes. Fees must be paid prior to playing or their score will be thrown out and not count. They will have to pay the weekend rate for 9 holes. (2011)
16. Each score card must be completely filled out and signed by one member of each team to verify the calculations and scores on that card. If a team member does not sign their card, then the points they scored on that card will be thrown out. If neither team signs, then the whole card will be thrown out. (1996)
